SUBJECT: Operations Update

Dear Staff,

On April 7, the Premier of Ontario declared a provincial emergency under s 7.0.1 (1) of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act (EMPCA) and issued a provincial Stay-at-Home Order, which took effect today for at least 28 days. In response to this announcement, and with guidance from the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services and Public Health, additional modifications will be implemented as outlined below. All other programs will continue as previously advised on April 5.

Day Activities

On site Day Activity programs will remain suspended until at least May 7, 2021. A schedule is being developed for staff to visit one (1) individual each day for an outdoor visit. Staff will receive communication regarding this schedule and their work assignments and are to continue to arrive for work, as directed.

Virtual activities will continue to be offered to the individuals that access these services through the Recreation department.

Services will not include any form of transportation during this time.
