UPDATE

To the individuals we support, their families, and our community partners,

On May 28, the Premier of Ontario announced that the provincial Stay-at-Home Order will expire on June 2, 2021. The province's emergency brake remains in place at this time until the province is ready to enter Step One of Ontario's [Roadmap to Reopen](#). In response to this announcement, we are providing an update by program below:

DAY ACTIVITIES

On site Day Activity programs will remain suspended until at least June 11, 2021. Modified supports will continue, including virtual activities.

VISITORS

Visitor permissions will remain as directed by Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services and Public Health.

ADULT CLINICAL

We will continue providing services via telepractice through phone, email and videoconference. Face-to-face services will be provided on a case by case basis.

CHILDREN'S SERVICES

Children's Services will continue to operate with the current level of capacity.

ADMINISTRATION

Our administrative staff will return to work out of our Schmon and Fly Road locations on a partial rotating basis.

Your continued patience and understanding is appreciated and we will continue to provide updates as we learn more from the Ontario Government, Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services, and Public Health.
