On June 24, the Premier of Ontario announced that the province will be moving into Step Two of Ontario's [Roadmap to Reopen](#) effective today, June 30. With this encouraging step forward, I am pleased to advise the following program update:

**DAY ACTIVITIES**

Day Activities will resume effective, Monday, July 5, for those individuals living within the Familyhome program.

**VISITORS**

Visitor permissions will remain as directed by the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services and Public Health; we are anticipating changes in the very near future.

All other programs will remain as previously communicated.

Reflecting on this past year, we entered last summer with some apprehension as we navigated the pandemic and the safety restrictions that this brought. This summer brings optimism, with the accelerated rollout of vaccines, careful reopening of our economy and, most importantly, more opportunities to socialize with our loved ones. While we must remain vigilant and continue to adhere to Public Health guidance, for the safety of all, there is renewed hope that we are nearing the end of this pandemic.
