I wanted to update you that a staff working at one of our residential programs at Fly Road has tested positive for COVID-19. We wish this staff all the best and a speedy recovery. Since receiving notification of such, we have been working diligently with Public Health and I am pleased to communicate that at this time this is the only confirmed case of COVID-19 we have. We will continue to work with Public Health to minimize the effects of this situation on others.

Based on Public Health's direction and determination this situation will be deemed as an outbreak and listed on their website as such. I want to reiterate, this is the only case of COVID-19 associated with Bethesda at this time and preventative measures have been implemented to minimize the risk associated with this situation.

I want to communicate the extension of our previously announced service delivery modifications and program closures. These will continue until May 17, 2020.
